The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 24 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 25 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 26 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 27 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 28 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 29 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 30 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the President or Chancellor, will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or 31 32 upon release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief 33 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the 34 Board approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal 35 year. 36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

3	SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
4	by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

6	restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
7	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

14	SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

17	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
21	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

23	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
24	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
25	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
26	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
27	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
29	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
30	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
31	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
32	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
33	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
