1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOOD 2 SERVICE. If Henderson State University cancels the current contract for food 3 service and chooses to operate the food service with University employees, 4 the President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to 5 utilize the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided 6 he or she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and 7 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the 8 Arkansas Legislative Council.

9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
10 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

11

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 13 SPECIAL 14 ALLOWANCE. The Board of Trustees of Henderson State University may make 15 special allowances available to any coach who coaches more than one sport in 16 an amount not to exceed \$10,000 per fiscal year for any one coach during each 17 year of the 2007-2009 biennium. Further, if the special allowance funds authorized herein are utilized, Henderson State University shall report 18 19 annually to the Legislative Joint Auditing Committee the exact disposition of 20 those special allowance funds.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
22 <u>2009</u> through June 30, 2009 <u>2010</u>.

24 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 26 CONSTRUCTION. The Board of <u>Trustees of Henderson State University shall be</u> 27 included as an exempt institution related to projects exceeding five million 28 dollars (\$5,000,000) provided that the institution shall have adopted policies and procedures involving the awarding and oversight of the contracts 29 30 for design and construction services in compliance with State Law. 31 32 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 34 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged

35 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 36 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief

1 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 2 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 3 4 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 5 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 6 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 7 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 8 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 9 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 10 11 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

13 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 16 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 19 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 20 21 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 22 with in disbursement of said funds.

23

24 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 31 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

33 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

35 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

36 <u>effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of</u>

1	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
2	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
3	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
4	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
5	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
6	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
7	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
