21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 16, Subchapter 11 is
24 amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

25 27-16-1110. Expiration of identification cards when the applicant is
26 not a United States citizen.

27 (a) If an applicant for an identification card under this chapter is
28 not a citizen of the United States as provided under § 27-16-
29 1105(a)(1)(D)(ii)–(ix), the expiration date of the identification card shall
30 be the shortest of:

31 (1) The period provided for under § 27-16-805(b);

32 (2) The date shown on the applicant's *Division of Immigration*
33 *and Customs Enforcement of the Department of Homeland Security* document I-94;
34 or

35 (3) The last date the applicant may be present in the United
36 States under federal immigration laws, as verified by the *Division of*



1 Immigration and Customs Enforcement of the Department of Homeland Security.
2 (b) The Office of Driver Services may renew the card only if it is
3 demonstrated that the applicant's continued presence in the United States is
4 authorized under federal law.
