SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS 10 11 FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas House of Representatives, 12 to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for the balance remaining on June 30, 2009 in the appropriations enacted to defray the 13 14 necessary expenses of the House of Representatives of the Eighty-seventh 15 General Assembly, Act 2 of 2007, Section 2 of Act 3 of 2007, Sections 4 and 16 11 of Act 308 of 2007, Act 1 of the First Extraordinary Session of 2008 and 17 Act 2 of 2009, there to be used for the same purposes for the Arkansas House 18 of Representatives of the Eighty-seventh General Assembly, in a sum in the 19 aggregate not to exceed.....\$3,757,135. 20

29 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF 31 FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the 32 necessary expenses of the operation of the Office of the Speaker of the House 33 of Representatives, the Office of the Coordinator of House Legislative 34 Services, the Office of Parliamentarian, the Chief Clerk's Office, House 35 Constituency Services Office and other reasonable and necessary expenses of 36 the House of Representatives of the General Assembly incurred during the

5 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 7 AUTHORITY. If the Speaker of the House and the Coordinator of House 8 Legislative Services determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated 9 herein for a specific purpose is not needed for such purpose, they may 10 certify such fact to the State Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause a 11 transfer to be made from one item to another.

13 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 14 SALARIES. 15 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and 16 retained, the House of Representatives may exceed the maximum salary levels 17 by no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the 18 positions authorized in their biennial operation appropriation act, may 19 exceed the maximum salary levels for the purpose of merit adjustments for all positions, and may promote a maximum of two grades for no more than one-third 20 21 (1/3) of the classified positions authorized in its biennial operation 22 appropriation act.

SECTION 16. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 24 25 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 26 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 27 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 31 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

34 SECTION 17. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

1	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
2	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
3	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
4	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
5	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
6	
7	SECTION 18. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
8	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
9	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
10	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
11	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
12	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
13	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
14	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
15	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
16	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
17	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
