34	SECTION 1. APPROPRIA	ATION - SUPPLEMENTAL COUNTY AND MU	NICIPAL AID. There	
35	is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -			
36	Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its			



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1 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For supplementing the distribution of funds apportioned to each city or incorporated town in the same proportion as authorized in Arkansas Code 19-5-601, the sum of\$3,000,000.
(B) For supplementing the funds made available to each of the seventy-five counties by the same distribution as authorized in Arkansas Code 19-5-602(c)(1)(A), the sum of\$3,000,000.

9 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>No less</u> 11 <u>than thirty (30) days prior to the distribution of any funds appropriated by</u> 12 <u>this act, the director of the agency shall notify the Speaker of the House of</u> 13 <u>Representatives of the name and address of each recipient and the amount that</u> 14 <u>is being distributed to each recipient.</u>

16 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 17 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 18 19 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 20 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 21 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 22 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 23 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 24 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 25 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 26 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 27 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

35 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 36 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

1	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act		
2	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations		
3	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

8	SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
9	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the		
10	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the		
11	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of		
12	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in		
13	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective		
14	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the		
15	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.		
16	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being		
17	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and		
18	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
