17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
18

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code §19-5-303(a)(3)(B) concerning sources of
20 special revenue for the University of Arkansas Fund, is amended to read as
21 follows:

22 (a)(3)(B) Those special revenues as set out in §19-6-301(45), ~~(114)~~, (229)
23 and (232); and
24

25 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code §19-5-961(b) concerning sources of special
26 revenues for the Solid Waste Management and Recycling Fund, is amended to
27 read as follows:

28 (b) Such fund shall consist of those special revenues specified in §19-
29 6-301(154) and (239), reimbursement of funds pursuant to § 8-6-610, federal
30 funds which may become available, interest earnings, gifts, donations, and
31 any other funds made available by the General Assembly, there to be
32 administered by the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality as set out
33 in §8-6-601 et seq.
34

35 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code §19-5-1103(b) concerning sources of special
36 revenue for the Property Tax Relief Trust Fund, is amended to read as



1 follows:

2 (b) The fund shall consist of such revenues as generated by §§ 26-52-302(c),
3 26-52-317(c)(1)(B), 26-52-319(a)(3)(B), 26-53-107(c), ~~and~~ 26-53-145(c)(1)(B),
4 26-53-148(a)(3)(B), and 26-56-224(c)(2), and shall be used for such purposes
5 as set out in § 26-26-310.

6

7 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 11 is amended
8 to add an additional section to read as follows:

9 19-5-1136. Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund.
10 The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund shall consist
11 of those special revenues as specified in subdivision (104) of § 19-6-301,
12 there to be used to defray the costs of operating the Arkansas Department of
13 Environmental Quality as set out in §§ 8-1-101 – 8-1-107.

14

15 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code §19-5-1227(b)(3), concerning sources of
16 revenue for the Educational Adequacy Fund is amended to read as follows:

17 (b)(3) The revenues generated by §§ 26-52-302(d), 26-52-316, 26-52-
18 317(c)(1)(C), 26-52-319(a)(3)(C), 26-53-107(d), 26-53-145(c)(1)(C), 26-53-
19 148(a)(3)(C), 26-56-224(c)(3) and 26-57-1002(d)(1)(A)(ii); and

21 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 12 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 19-5-1236. Innovate Arkansas Fund.

24 (a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
25 Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be
26 known as the "Innovate Arkansas Fund".

27 (b) The Innovate Arkansas Fund shall consist of funds as may be
28 provided for by law.

29 (c) The Innovate Arkansas Fund shall be used by the Arkansas Economic
30 Development Commission for the sole support of a contract between the
31 department and the entity selected to provide support and assistance for
32 development and growth of knowledge-based and technology-based companies in
33 the State of Arkansas.

34

35 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code 19-5-401 is amended to read as follows:

36 19-5-401. Allocations for fiscal year 2009-10.

1 Commencing with the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30,
 2 2010, the Treasurer of State shall transfer all remaining general revenues
 3 available for distribution on the last day of business in July 2009, and on
 4 the last day of business in each calendar month thereafter during the fiscal
 5 year to the various funds and fund accounts participating in general revenues
 6 in the proportions of the maximum allocation as the individual allocation to
 7 the fund or fund account bears to the total of the maximum allocation as
 8 provided in § 19-5-402(a), (b-1), and (b).

9
 10 SECTION 8. Arkansas Code 19-5-402 is amended to read as follows:

11 19-5-402. Maximum allocations of revenues for fiscal year 2009-10.

12 (a) The Treasurer of State shall first make monthly allocations in the
 13 proportions set out in this subsection to the funds and fund accounts listed
 14 below until there has been transferred a total of four billion four hundred
 15 ninety-eight million seven hundred forty-nine thousand one hundred twelve
 16 dollars (\$4,498,749,112) or so much thereof as may become available;
 17 provided, that the Treasurer of State shall make such monthly allocations in
 18 accordance with each fund or fund account's proportionate part of the total
 19 of all such allocations set forth in this subsection:

1 SECTION 9. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
 2 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND TRANSFER. Immediately
 3 upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
 4 shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor
 5 of the State the sum of sixty one million forty-nine thousand one hundred
 6 twelve dollars (\$61,049,112) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund
 7 to the General Revenue Fund Account of the State Apportionment Fund to be
 8 distributed as all other general revenue.

11 SECTION 10. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR
 12 PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNCLAIMED PROPERTY
 13 FUND TRANSFER. (a) Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the
 14 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall direct the Auditor of State to
 15 deposit the sum of ten million dollars (\$10,000,000) from moneys collected
 16 pursuant to Arkansas Code 18-28-213 and which were deposited into the
 17 Unclaimed Property Proceeds Trust Fund into the General Revenue Fund Account
 18 of the State Apportionment Fund to be distributed as all other general
 19 revenue. (b) The deposit shall be made notwithstanding the provisions of
 20 Arkansas Code 18-28-213 (c)(2).

24 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by
 25 the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that changes in the state's
 26 fiscal laws must take effect at the beginning of the fiscal year, that if the
 27 current legislative session is extended such that the 90 day period is later
 28 than July 1, 2009 the changes will not be timely. Therefore, an emergency is
 29 declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the
 30 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
 31 on July 1, 2009.
