10 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
11 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS
12 LOTTERY COMMISSION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING
13 JUNE 30, 2009; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS LOTTERY
17 COMMISSION APPROPRIATION FOR THE
18 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.

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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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24 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas
25 Lottery Commission, to be payable from the Lottery Commission Trust Fund, for
26 personal services and operating expenses of the Arkansas Lottery Commission
27 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, the following:

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5 SECTION 2. FUND CREATED. LOTTERY COMMISSION TRUST FUND (a) There is hereby
6 created on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor of State, and Chief
7 Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to be known as the Lottery
8 Commission Trust Fund. (b) This fund shall consist of funds transferred from
9 the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund. (c) This fund shall also consist
10 of other monies as may be authorized by law. (d) The fund shall be used for
11 personal services and operating expenses associated with the Arkansas Lottery
12 Commission.

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14 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING
16 TRANSFER AND LOAN REPAYMENT. (a) Immediately upon the effective date of this
17 Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books
18 and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State the sum of six
19 million dollars (\$6,000,000) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund
20 to the Lottery Commission Trust Fund for a loan to provide start up funds for
21 the appropriation provided herein. (b) The Arkansas Lottery Commission shall
22 remit to the Treasurer of State the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000)
23 from the first six million dollars (\$6,000,000) of lottery proceeds received
24 from the Arkansas State Lottery as a repayment of the loan funds transferred
25 in (a) herein and the Treasurer of State shall credit the sum to the General
26 Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund.

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28 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
29 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
30 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
31 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
