16	(c)(1) An eligible applicant, including a surviving spouse under § 27-
17	24-208, for the issuance or renewal of any one (1) of the following special
18	license plates that existed before April 13, 2005, may obtain one (1)
19	additional special license plate under this subchapter upon payment of the
20	fee for licensing a motor vehicle as provided under § 27-14-601:

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8	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 24, Subchapter 2 is amended
9	to add an additional section to read as follows:
10	27-24-209. Retired members of the armed forces.
11	(a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall continue the
12	special license plate for retired members of the armed forces that existed
13	before the effective date of this act.
14	(b)(1) The department shall design the special license plates issued
15	under this section.
16	(2) In lieu of the legend, "The Natural State", or any
17	succeeding legend, there shall be placed across the bottom of the license
18	plate a permanent decal bearing the words "U.S. Armed Forces Retired".
19	(c) A retired member of the armed forces may apply for and annually
20	renew a special license plate issued under this section as provided under 27-
21	24-206 (a) and (b).
22	(d) Upon the initial application of a special license plate issued
23	under this section, a retired member of the armed forces shall provide
24	adequate proof to the department that he or she is a retired member of the
25	armed forces.
26	(e) The registration of a special license plate under this section may
27	continue from year to year as long as it is renewed each year within the time
28	and manner required by law.
29	
30	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 27-24-1301 is amended to read as follows:
31	27-24-1301. Purpose.
32	The purpose of this subchapter is to continue the special license
33	plates for the certain public service employees, $\underline{\text{or}}$ public service retirees,
34	or military service retirees that existed before April 13, 2005, and to
35	establish a procedure for other public service employees or retirees to
36	obtain special license plates.

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2	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 27-24-1302 is amended to read as follows:	
3	27-24-1302. Definitions.	
4	As used in this subchapter:	
5	(1) "Firefighter" means a person who is certified by the	
6	Arkansas Fire Protection Services Board as a certified firefighter or who has	
7	retired as a firefighter;	
8	(2) "Professional firefighter" means a person who is in good	
9	standing with the Arkansas Professional Fire Fighters Association;	
10	(3) "Public service" means a service provided by a city, a	
11	county, or the state government that requires licensure or certification by	
12	the person who is providing the service; and	
13	(4) "Retired member of the armed forces of the United States"	
14	means a person who presents proof of retirement in the form of retirement	
15	orders issued by one (1) of the following services of the armed forces of the	
16	United States:	
17	(A) The United States Army;	
18	(B) The United States Navy;	
19	(C) The United States Marine Corps;	
20	(D) The United States Air Force;	
21	(E) The United States Coast Guard; or	
22	(F) The National Guard; and	
23	$\frac{(5)}{(4)}$ "Retired state trooper" means a former employee of the	
24	Department of Arkansas State Police who is eligible for and is receiving	
25	retirement benefits related to the retiree's employment as a state trooper.

29	(a) The Department of Finance and Administration shall continue the	
30	special license plate for retired members of the armed forces of the United	
31	States that existed before April 13, 2005.	
32	(b)(1) The department shall design the special license plates issued	
33	under this section.	
34	(2) In lieu of the legend, "The Natural State" or any succeeding	
35	legend, there shall be placed across the bottom of the license plate a	
36	permanent decal bearing the words "U.S. Armed Forces Retired".	

1	(c)(1) A retired member of the armed forces may apply for and annually
2	renew a special license plate issued under this section.
3	(2) The fee for the initial application for a special license
4	plate under this section is the fee required by law for the registration and
5	licensing of the motor vehicle.
6	(3) The fee for the renewal of a special license plate under
7	this section is the fee required by law for the registration and licensing of
8	the motor vehicle.
9	(4) The replacement fee for a special license plate issued under
10	this section is ten dollars (\$10.00).
11	(d) Upon the initial application of a special license plate issued
12	under this section, the retired member of the armed forces shall provide
13	adequate proof to the department that he or she is a retired member of the
14	armed forces.
15	(e) The registration of a special license plate under this section
16	may:
17	(1) Continue from year to year as long as it is renewed each
18	year within the time and manner required by law; and
19	(2) Be renewed as provided under §§ 27-14-1012 and 27-14-1013.
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
