16	decal to the special license plate at the time of issuance to the applicant.
17	(7)(A) A fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be charged for the
18	medal decal under this subsection to be deposited to the credit of the
19	Military Funeral Honors Fund, § 19-6-811.
20	(B) An additional handling and administrative fee of one
21	dollar (\$1.00) shall be added to the cost of the medal decal under this
22	subsection for administrative costs.
23	(8) The medal decal under this subsection is optional and if it
24	is not purchased, the applicant will receive a branch decal as provided under
25	subsection (c) of this section.
26	(e) An applicant for a redesigned special license plate under this
27	section shall meet the requirements of this subchapter.
28	(f) Except as provided under subdivision (d)(7)(A) of this section,
29	the fee for issuance and renewal of a redesigned special license plate under
30	this section shall be as provided in § 27-24-206.
31	(g) Military service special license plates issued under this
32	subchapter before the effective date of this act shall be valid and are not

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2	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 6, Subchapter 8 is amended		
3	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
4	19-6-811. Military Funeral Honors Fund.		
5	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the		
6	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a special revenue		
7	fund to be known as the "Military Funeral Honors Fund".		
8	(b)(1) All moneys collected under § 27-24-209(d)(5)(A) shall be		
9	deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the fund as special		
10	revenues.		
11	(2) The fund shall also consist of any other revenues authorized		
12	by law.		
13	(c) The fund shall be used by the Department of Veterans' Affairs to		
14	assist with the cost of providing military funeral honors at veterans'		
15	funerals.		
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
