Academic Facilities Review Board. 17 (a) There is established the Academic Facilities Review Board to hear 18 the appeal filed by a public school district under § 6-20-2513(a) of a 19 20 determination of the Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 21 Transportation. 22 (b)(1) The board is composed of five (5) members appointed by the 23 Governor as follows: 24 (A) One (1) member who is a licensed building contractor 25 with five (5) years or more of experience in public school construction 26 selected from a list of three (3) names submitted to the Governor by the 27 Arkansas Chapter, Associated General Contractors; 28 (B) One (1) member who is a registered architect with at 29 least five (5) years of experience in public school design selected from a 30 list of three (3) names submitted to the Governor by the Arkansas Chapter, 31 American Institute of Architects; 32 (C) One (1) member who is a licensed or registered 33 engineer with at least five (5) years of experience in public school construction selected from a list of three (3) names submitted to the 34 35 Governor by the Arkansas Society of Professional Engineers/American Council 36 of Engineering Companies of Arkansas;

1	(D) One (1) member who is selected from a list of three

18	(d)(1) The Governor shall designate one (1) member to serve as chair
