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- (k)(1) The board shall appoint from its membership a liaison officer to the State Board of Education, the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board, the Department of Human Services, the Arkansas Employment Security Department, and the Arkansas Economic Development Commission.
 - (2) Liaison officers shall attend the board and council meetings or other appropriate meetings as designated by the chair and shall represent and articulate the policies of the board to these boards, councils, and agencies.

- 8 (c) The Arkansas Rehabilitation Services as an agency responsible to

- 11 Education shall function as an agency in accordance with § 6-52-101 et seq.

- 21 his or her office, shall act as agent of the board, and shall perform such

- 24 without vote.
- 25 (g) The person selected as director must be a person of good moral
- 26 character, recognized as a leader in the field of vocational or workforce
- 27 education, and qualified technically and by experience to direct the work of
- 28 the department.
- 29 (h) No person who is related within the fourth degree of consanguinity
- 30 or affinity to any member of the board shall be eligible to serve as director
- 31 of the department.
- 33 SECTION 5. (a) This act shall not be construed as impairing the
- 34 continued effectiveness of any rules or orders promulgated or issued by the
- 35 Department of Workforce Education or the State Board of Workforce Education
- 36 <u>and Career Opportunities before the effective date of this act.</u>

1	(b) This act shall not be construed as extinguishing or otherwise	
2	affecting the unexpired terms of any current members of the State Board of	
3	Workforce Education and Career Opportunities.	
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5	SECTION 6. The Arkansas Code Revision Commission shall make all	
6	changes in the Arkansas Code necessary to effectuate the intent of this act.	
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8	SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the	
9	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that this act renames the	
10	Department of Workforce Education and the State Board of Workforce Education	
11	and Career Opportunities and that the ideal time to implement these name	
12	changes is at the beginning of the state's fiscal year. Therefore, an	
13	emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the	
14	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective	
15	on July 1, 2009.	
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
