19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 4, Chapter 56, Subchapter 1 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 4-56-105. Hold harmless clause language – Clear and conspicuous.

24 (a) As used in this section

25 (1) "Clear" means language used in an ordinary way to convey
26 information so that a reasonable person understands its meaning.

27 (2) "Conspicuous" means attracting attention to language in a
28 contract so that a reasonable person will be alerted to its inclusion in the
29 contract, including, without limitation, the use of:

30 (A) Bold print;

31 (B) Capitalization;

32 (C) Contrasting color;

33 (D) Larger type;

34 (E) Underlining; and

35 (F) Unusual font.

36 (b) Language in a contract to indemnify, defend, waive, release, or



1 hold harmless a party to the contract from that party's liability in the
2 performance of the contract shall be clear and conspicuous to be enforceable
3 against another party to the contract.
