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19	SECTION 1. Ark	ansas Code § 7-5-211 is amended to	read as follows:

- 22 supervision of voting machines and electronic vote tabulating devices used
- 23 for early voting in the clerk's at the designated early voting location.

- 25 SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-5-401 is amended to read as follows:
- 7-5-401. Duties of county clerk.
- 27 (a) The county clerk shall be the custodian of the absentee ballots
- 28 and early voting ballots for any early voting conducted by the county clerk.
- 29 (b) The county clerk shall be furnished a suitable room at the county
- 30 courthouse or other location designated for the purpose of exercising all the
- 31 powers and duties concerning the application for, the issuance of, and the
- 32 voting of absentee and early voting ballots required by law of the county
- 33 clerk.
- 34 (c) In counties with more than one (1) county seat, the county clerk

- 36 (1) Absentee absentee voting in the courthouse or other room provided

1 by the county; and 2 (2) Early voting at the county clerk's designated early voting 3 location in each county seat if the county clerk conducts early voting under 4 $\frac{\$}{\$}$ 7-5-418. 5 6 SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-5-413(a) and (b), concerning the use of 7 voting machines in early voting, is amended to read as follows: 8 (a)(1) At least one (1) voting machine equipped for use by individuals 9 with disabilities shall be placed in the county clerk's designated early 10 voting location for early voting for the election in accordance with this 11 subchapter and at any off-site polling locations established by the county 12 board. 13 Those persons entitled under the law to vote early by 14 personal appearance shall cast their votes on voting systems under the laws 15 applicable to early voting, and the clerk or election official shall enter 16 the name of each voter on a list at the time he or she votes. 17 (b) After regular business hours, the election official at the elerk's designated early voting location or the election official at any off-18 19 site polling place shall secure the machines against further voting at the close of each day's voting in the presence of authorized poll watchers, if 20 21 any. When early voting is concluded, the clerk or the election official shall 22 secure the machines against further voting. 2.3 24 SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 7-5-415 is amended to read as follows: 25 7-5-415. Compensation of county clerk for extra deputy. 26 The county clerk's budget shall be paid not less than minimum wage for 27 a period not to exceed thirty-five (35) days for hiring one (1) extra deputy 28 for the purpose of carrying out the requirements of this act. The fee for 29 this one (1) extra deputy shall be established and paid by the county, city, 30 or other political subdivision, the representatives of which call the 31 election, or in the case of a state-funded election, by the State Board of Election Commissioners. Any additional deputies beyond the one (1) extra 32 33 deputy may be hired as necessary to carry out the purposes of early voting 34 and absentee voting, if approved and paid by the quorum court of the county. 35 In the regular general election, the fee for the one (1) extra deputy or

additional deputies shall be paid by the county.

1 2 SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 7-5-418(a) and (b), concerning the times and locations of early voting, is amended to read as follows: 3 4 (a)(1)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this section, 5 early voting shall be available to any qualified elector who applies to the 6 county clerk's designated early voting location, beginning fifteen (15) days 7 before a preferential primary or general election between the hours of 8:00 8 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 10:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. 9 Saturday and ending at 5:00 p.m. on the Monday before the election. 10 (B) Early voting shall not be available on state or county 11 holidays. 12 (2) However, on for all other elections, including presidential preferential primary, general primary, and general runoff elections, early 13 14 voting shall be available to any qualified elector who applies to the county 15 clerk during regular office hours designated early voting location between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, beginning seven 16 17 (7) days before the election and ending on the day before the election day at 18 the time the county clerk's office regularly closes 5:00 p.m. 19 (b)(1) The county board of election commissioners shall designate an early voting location. 20 21 (1)(2)(A) The county board of election commissioners may decide 22 to hold early voting at additional polling sites outside the offices of the 23 county clerk designated early voting location on any of the days and times 24 provided for in subsection (a) of this section, if it so chooses. 25 (B) The county board shall determine by unanimous vote the 26 location of additional polling sites for early voting. 27 The county board shall appoint the election officials for 28 the additional early voting polling site or sites in the same manner as 29 election officials are appointed for election day. 30 (3)(A) The county board shall notify the county clerk of its 31 decision to hold early voting at additional polling sites outside the office

15	stored in a secure location in the county courthouse or in a secure location		
16	as determined by the county board of election commissioners immediately after		
17	the close of the additional polling sites each day that early voting is		
18	conducted there.		
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
