6	As used in this subchapter:

9	(2) "Director" means the Director of the Department of Finance

12	means a commercial motor vehicle operator's license issued under this
13	<u>chapter;</u>
14	(4) "Voluntary enhanced security driver's license" means a motor

19	(2) A voluntary enhanced security driver's license issued under
20	this subchapter may be used for all state purposes authorized for driver's
21	licenses otherwise issued under this Title 27 of the Arkansas Code.
22	(b)(1) In addition to the requirements of this subchapter, the
23	issuance, renewal, and use of a voluntary enhanced security identification
24	card shall be subject to the requirements and fees for obtaining, renewing,
25	and using a identification card otherwise issued under this Title 27 of the
26	Arkansas Code.
27	(2) A voluntary enhanced security identification card issued
28	under this subchapter may be used for all state purposes authorized for
29	identification cards otherwise issued under this Title 27 of the Arkansas

20	As an alternative to applying for the standard driver's license,
21	commercial driver's license, or identification card under other subchapters
22	of this chapter, a person may apply for a voluntary enhanced security
23	driver's license, voluntary enhanced security commercial driver's license, or
24	voluntary enhanced security identification card under this subchapter.

26	<u>27-16-1207. Issuance standards — Proof of physical address.</u>
27	(a) In addition to the information required under § 27-16-1105, an
28	applicant for a voluntary enhanced security driver's license, voluntary
29	enhanced security commercial driver's license, or voluntary enhanced security
30	identification card under this subchapter must present two (2) of the
31	following documents upon application or renewal that show the name and
32	physical residential address of the applicant:
33	(1)(A) Utility bill;
34	(B) Current lease or rental agreement;
35	(C) Bank statement;
36	(D) Mortgage statement;

2	(F) Current insurance policy;

27	The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall
28	require before issuing a voluntary enhanced security driver's license,

32	(1) Is a citizen or national of the United States;
33	(2) Is an alien lawfully admitted for permanent or temporary
34	residence in the United States;

13	27-16-1209. Expiration and renewal of voluntary enhanced security
14	driver's licenses and identification cards.
15	(a) A voluntary enhanced security driver's license, voluntary enhanced
16	security commercial driver's license, and voluntary enhanced security
17	identification card issued to a United States citizen or United States
18	national under this subchapter shall expire at the time provided for other
19	driver's licenses, commercial driver's licenses, and identification cards
20	issued under this Title 27 of the Arkansas Code.
21	(b)(1) Every voluntary enhanced security driver's license, voluntary
22	enhanced security commercial driver's license, or voluntary enhanced security
23	identification card issued to an applicant other than a United States citizen
24	or United States national shall expire on the date indicated in subsection
25	(b)(2) of this section if the applicant provides valid documentary evidence
26	of legal status that the person:
27	(A) Is an alien lawfully admitted for permanent or
28	temporary residence in the United States;
29	(B) Has conditional permanent resident status in the
30	United States;
31	(C) Has a valid, unexpired nonimmigrant visa or
32	nonimmigrant visa status for entry into the United States;
33	(D) Has a pending or approved application for asylum in
34	the United States;
35	(E) Has entered into the United States in refugee status;
36	(F) Has a pending or approved application for temporary

1	protected status in the United States;
2	(G) Has approved deferred action status; or
3	(H) Has a pending application for adjustment of status to

6	(2)(A) If the applicant for issuance or renewal of a voluntary
7	enhanced security driver's license, voluntary enhanced security commercial
8	driver's license, or voluntary enhanced security identification card provides
9	valid documentary evidence of legal status with no expiration date, the
10	driver's license or identification card issued shall expire on the end of the
11	month in which the driver's license or identification card was issued one (1)
12	year from its date of initial issuance.
13	(B) If the applicant for issuance or renewal of a
14	voluntary enhanced security driver's license, voluntary enhanced security
15	commercial driver's license, or voluntary enhanced security identification
16	card provides valid documentary evidence of legal status containing an
17	expiration date, the driver's license or identification card issued shall
18	expire on the earlier to occur of the following:
19	(i) The date of expiration indicated on the person's
20	valid documentary evidence of legal status; or
21	(ii) The expiration date listed in subdivisions
22	(b)(1) or (b)(2)(A) of this section.
23	(3) The Office of Driver Services of the Department of Finance
24	and Administration shall verify the legal presence of an applicant for
25	renewal of a voluntary enhanced security driver's license, voluntary enhanced
26	security commercial driver's license, or voluntary enhanced security
27	identification card of a person included in subdivisions (b)(1) or (b)(2)(A)
28	of this section by utilizing the automated system known as the Verification
29	Information System database of the Systematic Alien Verification for

32	(c) A voluntary enhanced security driver's license, voluntary enhanced
33	security commercial driver's license, or voluntary enhanced security

36	extent applicable, other renewal provisions in this chapter.

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1	(d) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may
2	by rule shorten or lengthen the term of any driver's license or
3	identification card period under this section, as necessary, to ensure that
4	approximately twenty-five percent (25%) of the total valid licenses are
5	renewable each fiscal year.

7	27-16-1210. Enhanced security card issuance and renewal fees.
8	(a) The fee for the initial issuance of a voluntary enhanced security
9	driver's license, voluntary enhanced security commercial driver's license, or
10	voluntary enhanced security identification card under this subchapter is the
11	same as the fee for initial issuance of other driver's licenses, commercial
12	driver's licenses, and identification cards listed in Title 27 of the
13	Arkansas Code.
14	(b) The fee for the renewal of a voluntary enhanced security driver's
15	license, voluntary enhanced security commercial driver's license, or
16	voluntary enhanced security identification card under § 27-16-1209(a) is the
17	same as the fee for renewal of other driver's licenses, commercial driver's
18	licenses, and identification cards listed in Title 27 of the Arkansas Code.
19	(c) The fee for the renewal of a voluntary enhanced security driver's
20	license, voluntary enhanced security commercial driver's license, or
21	voluntary enhanced security identification card under § 27-16-1209(b) is the
22	same as the fee for renewal of other driver's licenses, commercial driver's
23	licenses, and identification cards listed in this chapter, subject to a pro
24	rata reduction in the renewal fee for any shortened renewal period under §
25	<u>27-16-1209(b)</u> .
26	(d) The renewal fee for a license or identification card that expires
27	as provided in § 27-16-1209(b)(2) is an amount calculated by multiplying the
28	amount of a renewal fee whose term is not shortened by a fraction whose
29	numerator is the number of months for which the renewal license or
30	identification card is issued and whose denominator is the number of months
31	that would have applied had the renewal time not been shortened.
32	
33	27-16-1211. Authority to promulgate rules.
34	The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may
35	promulgate any necessary rules to carry out this subchapter, subject to the
36	Arkansas Administrative Procedure Act, § 25-15-201 et seq.

2	27-16-1212. Implementation date.
3	(a) This subchapter shall be effective and shall be implemented only
4	if the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration:
5	(1) Determines that the voluntary enhanced identification and
6	security features under this subchapter are necessary to ensure secure
7	commerce and travel by Arkansas citizens within and throughout the State of
8	Arkansas, the United States, and abroad; and
9	(2) Promulgates a rule specifying the date of implementation of
10	this subchapter.
11	
12	SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall expire on June 30, 2013.
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
