## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ALLOW A TWO-YEAR OR FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE  
10 OR UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE CONCURRENT CREDIT  
11 COURSES TO HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AT A REDUCED  
12 TUITION *AMOUNT*; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO ALLOW A TWO-YEAR OR FOUR-YEAR COLLEGE  
16 OR UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE CONCURRENT  
17 CREDIT COURSES AT A REDUCED TUITION

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 61, Subchapter 1 is amended*  
24 *to add an additional section to read as follows:*

25 *6-61-134. Tuition and enrollment for concurrent enrollment courses.*

26 *(a) As used in this section, "concurrent enrollment course" means a*  
27 *college level course offered by an institution of higher education that upon*  
28 *completion would qualify for academic credit in both the institution of*  
29 *higher education and a public high school.*

30 *(2) "Concurrent enrollment course" also includes an endorsed*  
31 *concurrent enrollment course.*

32 *(b) A state-supported two-year or four-year college or university may*  
33 *offer a reduced tuition amount for a concurrent enrollment course.*

34 *(c) For the purpose of calculating state funding for institutions of*  
35 *higher education under law or rule of the Arkansas Higher Education*  
36 *Coordinating Board:*
