17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1 is amended
20 to add an additional section to read as follows:

21 5-12-104. Aggravated shoplifting.

22 (a) A person commits aggravated shoplifting if the person:

23 (1) Engages in conduct giving rise to the presumption under § 5-
24 36-102(c) with the purpose of committing a misdemeanor theft; and

25 (2) Employs or threatens to immediately employ physical force
26 upon another person with the purpose of resisting apprehension immediately
27 after engaging in the conduct described in subdivision (a)(1) of this
28 section.

29 (b) Aggravated shoplifting is a Class D felony.
