27	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-17-1006(10), concerning the powers and		
28	duties of the Arkansas Cemetery Board, is amended to read as follows:		
29	(10) Increase, in accordance with regulations adopted by the		
30	board, the percentage of the gross proceeds of the sale of any grave space,		
31	crypt, niche, or similar entombment required to be deposited into the		
32	permanent maintenance fund of the cemetery in accordance with § 20-17-1016		
33	whenever it is determined that the principal of the permanent maintenance		
34	fund is or will be insufficient to generate enough income to operate and		
35	maintain the cemetery By rule increase the amount of a deposit required by §		
36	20-17-1016 if the board determines that a greater sum is necessary to assure		

1	that the permanent maintenance fund will earn sufficient income to provide		
2	for the care and maintenance of the cemetery; and		
3			
4	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-17-1016(a), concerning deposits required		
5	for a cemetery company's permanent maintenance fund, is amended to read as		
6	follows:		
7	(a) Each Unless a greater amount is established by rule of the		
8	Arkansas Cemetery Board under § 20-17-1006(10), a cemetery company shall		
9	deposit not less than ten percent (10%) of the gross proceeds of each sale		
10	into the permanent maintenance fund, provided cemetery companies selling		
11	crypts, niches, or similar entombments shall be required to deposit into a		
12	permanent maintenance fund an amount not less than the Arkansas Cemetery		
13	Board shall by order require if the cemetery company can demonstrate to the		
14	board that such lesser amount will be sufficient for perpetual maintenance		
15	and upkeep into its permanent maintenance fund a sum not less than:		
16	(1) Twenty percent (20%) of the gross proceeds from the sale of		
17	a lot or grave space in its cemetery; and		
18	(2) Five percent (5%) of the gross proceeds from the sale of a		
19	mausoleum crypt, lawn crypt, niche, or other similar entombment in its		
20	<pre>cemetery.</pre>		
21			
22	SECTION 4. Effective date.		
23	This act takes effect January 10, 2010.
