18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 37, Subchapter 2 is amended
21 to add a new section to read as follows:

22 5-37-215. Use of a false identity to obtain employment.

23 (a)(1) A person commits use of a false identity to obtain employment
24 if the person knowingly supplies a false identity by using a name, date of
25 birth, or social security number not his or her own to a prospective employer
26 in order to obtain employment.

27 (2) It is not a defense under this section that the prospective
28 employer knew that the identity given was false or that the person whose
29 identity was used falsely allowed its use by the person.

30 (b) Use of a false identity to obtain employment is a Class D felony.
