## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to Clarify that an OWNER of a boat livery SHALL RECORD THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF A MOTORBOAT; TO REQUIRE A BOAT LIVERY TO NOT ALLOW A VESSEL TO DEPART FROM THE PREMISES WITHOUT THE EQUIPMENT REQUIRED BY LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CLARIFY THAT AN OWNER OF A BOAT
LIVERY SHALL RECORD THE REGISTRATION NUMBER OF A MOTORBOAT; TO REQUIRE AN OWNER OF A BOAT LIVERY TO NOT ALLOW A VESSEL TO DEPART FROM THE PREMISES WITHOUT THE EQUIPMENT REQUIRED BY LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27-101-204. Duties of boat livery owner.
(a) The owner of a boat livery shall cause to be kept a record of:
(1) The name and address of the person or persons hiring any vessel which is designed or permitted by him or her to be operated as a motorboat;
(2) The registration number thereof of the vessel if the vessel is designed or permitted to be operated as a motorboat;
(3) The departure date and time;
(4) The expected time of return; and
(5) The number of persons to be on board the vessel.

[^0]:    (b) The record shall be preserved for at least six (6) months.
    (c) Neither the owner of a boat livery nor his or her agent or employee shall permit any motorboat or any a vessel designed owned or permitted by him or her to be operated as a motorboat to depart from his or her premises unless it shall have been the boat livery has provided, either by owner or renter, with the vessel with the equipment required pursuant to under § 27-101-203(a) and any rules and regulations made pursuant thereto under that section.
