19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-15-202 is amended to read as follows	:
22	12-15-202. Eligibility to carry concealed handgun.	
23	(a) Any certified law enforcement officer may carry a concealed	
24	handgun if that officer is:	
25	(1) Presently in the employ of a public law enforcement	
26	department, office, or agency;	
27	(2) Authorized by the public law enforcement department, off	
28	or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her duties	
29	(3) Not subject to any disciplinary action by the public law	
30	enforcement department, office, or agency;	
31	(4) Carrying a badge and appropriate written identification	
32 33	issued by the public law enforcement department, office, or agency	
33	identifying him or her as a certified law enforcement officer; and (5) Not otherwise prohibited under federal law.	
35	(b)(l) A concealed handgun may be carried by any retired law	
36	enforcement officer who:	

1	(A) Retired <u>in good standing</u> from service with <u>ten (10)</u>
2	years or more of aggregate service as a certified law enforcement officer
3	authorized by a law enforcement department, office, or agency to carry a
4	firearm in the course and scope of his or her duties with a public law
5	enforcement department, office, or agency $\underline{\text{and retired}}$ for reasons other than
6	mental disability;
7	(B) Immediately before retirement was a certified law
8	enforcement officer authorized by a public law enforcement department,
9	office, or agency to carry a firearm in the course and scope of his or her
10	duties;
11	$\frac{(C)}{(B)}$ Is carrying appropriate written identification
12	containing a photo issued by a public law enforcement department, office, or
13	agency identifying him or her as a retired and former certified law
14	enforcement officer;
15	$\frac{(D)}{(C)}$ Is not otherwise prohibited under state or federal
16	law;
17	$\frac{(E)}{(D)}$ Has <u>his or her</u> fingerprint impressions on file with
18	the Department of Arkansas State Police <u>automated fingerprint identification</u>
19	system together with written authorization for state and national level
20	criminal history record <u>fingerprint-based</u> screening; and
21	(F)(E) During the most recent twelve month period has <u>Has</u>
22	met, at the expense of the retired <u>certified</u> law enforcement officer, the
23	standards of this state for training and qualification for active law
24	enforcement officers to carry firearms+; and
25	(F) Is not under the influence of alcohol or an
26	intoxicating or hallucinatory drug or substance.
27	(2)(A) The chief law enforcement officer of the city or county
28	${\color{red}{\mathrm{shall}}}$ ${\color{red}{\mathrm{may}}}$ keep a record of all retired law enforcement officers authorized to
29	carry a concealed handgun in his or her jurisdiction and shall revoke any
30	authorization request revocation of the authorization from the Director of
31	the Department of Arkansas State Police for good cause shown.
32	(B) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State
33	Police shall keep a record of all retired <u>certified law enforcement</u>
34	department officers authorized to carry a concealed handgun in the state
35	<u>under this section</u> and shall revoke any authorization for good cause shown.
36	(C) The director may promulgate rules to permit the

- 2 (c)(1)(A) A firearms instructor certified by the Arkansas Commission
 3 on Law Enforcement Standards and Training who is employed by any certified
 4 law enforcement agency in this state may certify or recertify that a retired
 5 law enforcement officer has met the training and qualification requirements
- 6 for certification set by the commission for active law enforcement officers
- 7 to carry firearms.
- 8 (B) A retired <u>certified</u> law enforcement officer shall pay
- 9 the expenses for meeting the training and qualification requirements
- 10 described in subdivision (c)(1)(A) of this section.
- 11 (C) A firearms safety training instructor registered and
- 12 <u>in good standing with the Department of Arkansas State Police Concealed</u>
- 13 Handgun Carry Licensing Section may certify or recertify that a retired
- 14 <u>certified law enforcement officer has met the training and qualification</u>
- 15 requirements for certification set by the commission for active law
- 16 enforcement officers to carry firearms.
- 17 (2) A firearms instructor or a firearms safety training
- 18 <u>instructor under subdivision (c)(1) of this section</u> who certifies or
- 19 recertifies that a retired law enforcement officer has met the training and
- 20 qualification requirements for certification set by the commission for active
- 21 law enforcement officers to carry firearms under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of
- 22 this section shall complete and submit any required paperwork to the
- 23 commission.

- 24 (d) Any \underline{A} certified law enforcement officer or retired <u>certified</u> law enforcement officer carrying a concealed handgun under this section is not subject to the prohibitions and limitations of § 5-73-306.
- (e)(1) Any presently employed certified law enforcement officer
 authorized by another state to carry a concealed handgun shall be entitled to
 the same privilege may carry a concealed handgun while in this state, but is
 subject to the same restrictions of this section, provided that if the state
 which has authorized the certified law enforcement officer to carry a
 concealed handgun extends the same privilege to carry a concealed handgun to
- 33 presently employed Arkansas-certified law enforcement officers.
- 35 another state to carry a concealed handgun may carry a concealed handgun in

(2) A retired certified law enforcement officer authorized by

36 Arkansas while in this state, but is subject to the restrictions of this

2	enforcement officer to carry a concealed handgun extends the privilege to
3	carry a concealed handgun to retired Arkansas-certified law enforcement
4	officers.
5	(2) $\underline{(3)}$ The director shall make a determination as to which
6	states extend the privilege to carry a concealed handgun to presently
7	employed $\frac{Arkansas}{or}$ or certified law enforcement officers or retired certified
8	law enforcement officers $\underline{\text{in Arkansas}}$ and shall then determine which states'
9	officers' authority to carry concealed handguns will be recognized in
10	Arkansas.
