1	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 1 is amended
2	to add an additional section to read as follows:
3	6-60-104. Arkansas Safe Campus Task Force.
4	(a) There is hereby created a task force to be known as the "Arkansas
5	Safe Campus Task Force".
6	(b) The task force shall consist of eight (8) members including:
7	(1) The Director of the Department of Higher Education, or his
8	or her designee;
9	(2) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police, or
10	his or her designee;
11	(3) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Emergency
12	Management, or his or her designee;
13	(4) One (1) member appointed by the Governor who is trained in
14	treating persons affected mentally and emotionally by acts of violence;
15	(5) Two (2) members appointed by the Presidents Council who are
16	university presidents or chancellors, or their designees; and
17	(6) Two (2) members appointed by the Presidents Council who are
18	two-year college presidents, or their designees.
19	(c) If a vacancy occurs for any reason, the vacancy shall be filled in
20	the same manner as the original appointment.
21	(d) The Director of the Department of Higher Education shall organize
22	the first meeting of the task force and serve as chair at the first meeting.
23	(e)(1) By September 1, 2009, the task force shall conduct its first
24	meeting and elect a chair from among its membership.
25	(2) After its first meeting, the task force shall meet upon the
26	call of the chair, but shall meet no less than quarterly.
27	(3) The task force shall cease to exist after making its report
