AN ACT REGARDING THEFT OF CATTLE OR LIVESTOCK A
PERSON HAS WON AT AN AUCTION BUT WHO FAILS TO PAY
FOR THE CATTLE OR LIVESTOCK; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

REGARDING THEFT OF CATTLE OR LIVESTOCK A
PERSON HAS WON AT AN AUCTION BUT WHO
FAILS TO PAY FOR THE CATTLE OR
LIVESTOCK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. NOT TO BE CODIFIED.

The general purpose of this act is to specify the criminal liability
under the theft statutes of a person engaged in the cattle and livestock
business who takes possession of cattle and livestock he or she won in an
auction and subsequently fails to honor the verbal or written agreement by
remitting payment for the cattle or livestock.
