19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-202(a), concerning knowingly furnishing*
22 *or selling alcoholic beverages to a minor, is amended to read as follows:*

23 *(a)(1) It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to give, procure,*
24 *or otherwise furnish any alcoholic beverage to any person under twenty-one*
25 *(21) years of age. However, this section shall not apply to the serving of*
26 *such to one's family or to the use of wine or beer in any religious ceremony*
27 *or rite in any established church or religion.*
