4	SECTION 2. <u>Definitions.</u>		
5	As used in this act:		
6	(1) "Imitation gun" means a toy that has the appearance of being a		
7	firearm whether or not it is capable of discharging any shot, bullet or other		
8	missile; and		
9	(3) "Realistic imitation firearm" means and imitation gun that is		
10	indistinguishable from a real firearm.		
11			
12	SECTION 3. The Imitation Gun Public Safety Program.		
13	(a) There is created the Imitation Gun Public Safety Campaign.		
14	(b) The program is an initiative directed by leaders appointed in law		
15	enforcement, education, health care, and human services to educate children		
16	and parents about the risk of youths carrying imitation guns in public		
17	places, because realistic imitation firearms in public, could result in an		
18	armed police response and other health and safety risks.		
19	(c) The General Assembly shall:		
20	(1) Make it illegal to sell imitation guns or realistic		
21	imitation fire arms that could be mistaken for real firearms to children and		
22	youth under the age of eighteen (18);		
23	(2) Require that imitation guns be restricted from the toy		
24	section of major department stores without secure, locked protection, and		
25	posted information about the potential dangers of mistaking the imitation gur		
26	as real;		
27	(3) Emphasize to parents and children the dangers involved in		
28	possessing imitation firearms in public; and		
29	(4) Encourage and recommend to toy manufacturers who distribute		
30	imitation guns in Arkansas to design toys that clearly distinguish themselves		
31	from weapons.
