For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE CREATION, WITH COURT APPROVAL, OF A NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT IN PULASKI COUNTY BY WRITTEN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AND A SCHOOL DISTRICT INVOLVED IN THE "LITTLE ROCK SCHOOL DISTRICT V. PULASKI COUNTY SPECIAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 1" DESEGREGATION CASE FROM WHICH TERRITORY WILL BE DETACHED TO CREATE THE NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT; TO PROVIDE FOR THE FAIR AND EQUITABLE DIVISION OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES AMONG THE SCHOOL DISTRICTS INVOLVED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ALLOW THE CREATION OF A NEW SCHOOL DISTRICT IN PULASKI COUNTY AND PROVIDE FOR THE FAIR AND EQUITABLE DIVISION OF ASSETS AND LIABILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purposes of this act are to:

(1) Allow the creation, with court approval, of a new school district in Pulaski County by written agreement between the State Board of Education and a school district that is a party to the desegregation case styled "Little Rock School District v. Pulaski County Special School District No. 1", in the United States District Court, Western District of Arkansas, Eastern Division, from which territory will be detached to create the new

2 (2) Provide for the fair and equitable division of assets and
3 liabilities among the school districts involved.
