## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO RESTRICT THE CONSOLIDATION OR  
ANNEXATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS IF THE RESULTING  
SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL HAVE A LAND MASS AREA THAT  
EXCEEDS ONE THOUSAND SQUARE MILES (1,000 SQ.  
MI.); AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO RESTRICT THE CONSOLIDATION OR  
ANNEXATION OF SCHOOL DISTRICTS IF THE  
RESULTING SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL BE LARGER  
THAN ONE THOUSAND SQUARE MILES (1,000  
SQ. MI.).

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to restrict the consolidation or  
annexation of school districts if the resulting school district will have a  
land mass area that exceeds one thousand square miles (1,000 sq. mi.).
