## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO ALLOW STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF  
10 HIGHER EDUCATION THAT OFFER AN ASSOCIATE OF  
11 APPLIED SCIENCE DEGREE TO CHANGE THE ARKANSAS  
12 DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION MATH REQUIREMENT  
13 FROM "APPLIED MATHEMATICS, INTERMEDIATE ALGEBRA,  
14 OR HIGHER" TO "AN APPLICABLE AND APPROPRIATE  
15 NONREMEDIAL MATH COURSE"

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. The purpose of this act to allow state-supported  
28 institutions of higher education that offer an associate of applied science  
29 degree to change the Arkansas Department of Higher Education math requirement  
30 from "applied mathematics, intermediate algebra, or higher" to "an applicable  
31 and appropriate nonremedial math course".
