Stricken language would be deleted from and underlined language would be added to the law as it existed prior to this session of the General Assembly.

## For An Act To Be Entitled

an act to CLarify the requirements for CALCULATING AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP FOR THE PURPOSES OF ADMINISTRATIVE REORGANIZATION OF SMALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CLARIFY THE REQUIREMENTS FOR CALCULATING AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTRATIVE REORGANIZATION OF SMALL SCHOOL DISTRICTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. NOT TO BE CODIFIED. Intent. The General Assembly recognizes that the intent of basing administrative consolidation of small school districts on a two-year average was to provide temporary relief to school districts that were irreversibly losing enrollment. The General Assembly further recognizes that small school districts and the rural communities where they are located are more susceptible than larger communities to fluctuations in the economy that result in fluctuations in enrollment, both up and down. It is the intent of the General Assembly to provide a more stable basis for administrative consolidation of small school districts to minimize the effect of temporary fluctuations in enrollment due to changing economic conditions.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-13-1602 is amended to read as follows:

6-13-1602. Administrative consolidation list.
By February 1, 2004, and each January 1 thereafter of each year, the Department of Education shall publish a consolidation list that includes all school districts with fewer than three hundred fifty (350) students according to the school district average daily membership in each of the two (2) school years immediately preceding the current school year.
