20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-17-304(a), concerning the designation of
23 an institutional law enforcement officer, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a) The executive heads of each of the educational, charitable,
25 correctional, penal, and other institutions owned and operated by the State
26 of Arkansas, including the executive head of the Department of Parks and
27 Tourism and the executive head of the Arkansas Forestry Commission, are
28 authorized to designate and appoint one (1) or more of the employees of the
29 institutions and department, respectively, as an institutional law
30 enforcement officer or officers for the institution or at a state park, or
31 any separate portion of the institution or park, who shall exercise law
32 enforcement officer authority under the laws of this state.
