16	URGING THE SECRETARY OF THE UNITED
17	STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND THE
18	CONGRESS OF THE UNITED STATES TO SUPPORT
19	A VOLUNTARY MARKET-DRIVEN APPROACH TO
20	THE NATIONAL ANIMAL IDENTIFICATION
21	SYSTEM.

24	WHEREAS, the National Animal Identification System is a program
25	designed to assist the identification of a premise or an animal; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, the National Animal Identification System will enable the
28	United States Department of Agriculture to promote animal products in
29	restricted foreign markets that require the age and the source of an animal
30	product; and
31	
32	WHEREAS, access to restricted foreign markets will offer more
33	opportunities to add value to the animal products of farmers and ranchers;
34	and
35	
36	WHEREAS, the information that accompanies an animal identified through



1	the National Animal Identification System has a value for which farmers and
2	ranchers should be compensated in a free market society; and
3	
4	WHEREAS, participation in the National Animal Identification System has
5	the potential to add significant effort and cost to the raising and the
6	marketing of farm and ranch animals,
7	
8	THEREFORE,
9	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
10 11	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
12	That the Eighty-Seventh General Assembly of the State of Arkansas urges
13	the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture and the Congress
14	of the United States to allow the free market system to dictate the
15	implementation of a National Animal Identification System.
16	
17	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Eighty-Seventh General Assembly of the State
18	of Arkansas urges the Congress of the United States to prohibit mandatory
19	participation in the National Animal Identification System.
20	
21	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon adoption of this resolution, the Chief Clerk
22	of the House of Representatives shall transmit a copy of this resolution to
23	the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture and to each
24	member of Arkansas's congressional delegation.
