
16 COMMENDING DOUG SMALL ON HIS SELECTION

22 WHEREAS, Mr. Doug Small of Mountain Home has been a law enforcement  
23 official with the Arkansas State Game and Fish Commission for five (5) years;  
24 and

26 WHEREAS, In addition to Doug Small's duties enforcing hunting and  
27 fishing regulations, he devotes hundreds of hours toward enforcing boating  
28 laws and promoting safer use of Arkansas's lakes and waters; and

30 WHEREAS, Doug Small has spent over eight hundred (800) hours conducting  
31 boating patrols on his area lakes and rivers; has issued and assisted in  
32 twenty-one (21) boating under the influence arrests; and taught twelve (12)  
33 boating classes during the past year; and

35 WHEREAS, Doug Small has conducted ten (10) youth programs focused on  
36 boating safety and water recreation activities and assisted in a hands-on



1 boating education class for seventy-five (75) students; and

3 WHEREAS, Doug Small will represent Arkansas in the Southern States  
4 Boating Law Administrators Association of the Year competition,

6 NOW THEREFORE,

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL  
8 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
