Constitution of the United States requiring, in the absence of a national emergency, that the total of all federal appropriations made by Congress for any fiscal year may not exceed the total of all estimated federal revenues for that fiscal year, or alternatively, the General Assembly made application and requested the Congress of the United States to call a Constitutional Convention for the purpose of proposing such an amendment to the federal Constitution; and

9 WHEREAS, many legal experts believe that a convention, notwithstanding 10 whatever limitation might be placed upon it by the call of said convention, 11 would have within the scope of its authority the complete redrafting of the 12 Constitution of the United States, thereby creating a great danger to the 13 well-established rights of our people and to the constitutional principles 14 under which we are presently governed; and

16 WHEREAS, the Constitution of the United States has been extensively 17 interpreted and has proven to be a basically sound document which protects 18 the freedom of all Americans; and

20 WHEREAS, there is no need for a new constitution, the adoption of which 21 would create legal chaos in America and only begin the process of another two 22 centuries of litigation over its interpretation by the courts; and 23

24 WHEREAS, such changes as may be needed in the present Constitution of 25 the United States may be proposed and enacted by the well-established methods 26 of amendment contained therein,

28 NOW THEREFORE,

29 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
30 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

32 THAT the General Assembly does hereby rescind its application to the 33 Congress of the United States made by the General Assembly in 1979 by House 34 Joint Resolution 1 pursuant to Article V of the Constitution of the United 35 States for the calling of a constitutional convention for any purpose, 36 limited or general.
