9	AMENDING THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO REPEAL THE
10	PROHIBITION AGAINST AN ATHEIST HOLDING ANY OFFICE
11	IN THE CIVIL DEPARTMENTS OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS
12	OR TESTIFYING AS A WITNESS IN ANY COURT.

15	AMENDING THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO
16	REPEAL THE PROHIBITION AGAINST AN
17	ATHEIST HOLDING ANY OFFICE IN THE CIVIL
18	DEPARTMENTS OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS OR
19	TESTIFYING AS A WITNESS IN ANY COURT.

22	WHEREAS, the First Amendment of the United States Constitution declares
23	that Congress shall make no law respecting an establishment of religion or
24	prohibiting the free exercise thereof; and
25	
26	WHEREAS, Article 19 Section 1 of the Arkansas Constitution denies a
27	state office or the ability to testify in court to a person who denies the
28	being of a God; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, in Flora v. White, $692$ F.2d $53$ (8 <sup>th</sup> Cir. 1982), the United
31	States Eighth Circuit Court of Appeals suggested in a footnote that Article
32	19, Section 1 was unconstitutional under the principles of law enumerated in
33	Torcaso v. Watkins, 367 U.S. 488 (1961); and
34	
35	WHEREAS, Arkansas Attorney General Opinion 1992-164 likewise theorized
36	that Article 19, Section 1 would most likely be declared unconstitutional

1	upon an appropriate challenge,

3	NOW THEREFORE,
4	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-SEVENTH GENERAL
5	ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL
6	MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:
7	
8	That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of
9	the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state
10	for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives
11	and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election
12	adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of
13	the State of Arkansas, to wit:
14	
15	SECTION 1. Article 19, Section 1 of the Arkansas Constitution is
16	repealed.
17	§ 1. Atheists disqualified from holding office or testifying as
18	witness.
19	No person who denies the being of a God shall hold any office in the
20	civil departments of this State, nor be competent to testify as a witness in
21	any Court.
