## HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

be it resolved by the house of representatives of the eighty-seventh general ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE SENATE, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

That the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

SECTION 1. Subsection (c) of Section 14 of Article 19 of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas is amended to read as follows:
(c) Lottery proceeds shall not be subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and are specifically declared to be cash funds shall be held in trust separate and apart from within the State Treasury to be managed and maintained by the General Assembly or an agency or department of the State as
determined by the General Assembly.
