## For An Act To Be Entitled

10 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT APPROVAL OF CERTAIN  
11 COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS IN PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL  
12 INSTITUTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

14 TO PROHIBIT APPROVAL OF CERTAIN  
15 COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS IN PUBLIC  
16 EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-26-418(a), concerning public  
23 institutions, is amended to read as follows:

24 (a)(1) All public educational institutions operating cosmetological  
25 schools shall comply with the standards, rules, and regulations promulgated  
26 by the State Board of Cosmetology. However, the responsibility for approval  
27 of cosmetological schools in public educational institutions shall be the  
28 sole responsibility of the State Board of Workforce Education and Career  
29 Opportunities.

30 (2) The State Board of Workforce Education and Career  
31 Opportunities shall not approve a cosmetological school in a public  
32 educational institution if the public educational institution is within fifty  
33 (50) miles of a licensed private school of cosmetology approved by the State  
34 Board of Cosmetology.
