AN ACT TO PROHIBIT APPROVAL OF CERTAIN COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS IN PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROHIBIT APPROVAL OF CERTAIN COSMETOLOGICAL SCHOOLS IN PUBLIC EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-26-418(a), concerning public institutions, is amended to read as follows:
(a)(l) All public educational institutions operating cosmetological schools shall comply with the standards, rules, and regulations promulgated by the State Board of Cosmetology. However, the responsibility for approval of cosmetological schools in public educational institutions shall be the sole responsibility of the State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities.
(2) (A) The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities shall not approve a cosmetological school in a public educational institution if the public educational institution is within fifty (50) miles of a licensed private school of cosmetology approved by the State Board of Cosmetology.
(B) Subdivision (a)(2)(A) of this section shall not apply to a cosmetological school in a public educational institution in existence
on the effective date of this act.
