- 5 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such
- 6 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and
- 7 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the
- 8 <u>legal counsel to be retained by the agency, and</u>
- 9 (3) The Attorney General determines that the agency re-advertises
- 10 annually for legal counsel if outside legal counsel is hired and that any
- 11 amount to be paid for outside legal counsel has been reviewed and approved by
- 12 <u>the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.</u>
- 13 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the
- 14 employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with
- 15 <u>respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such</u>
- 16 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and
- 17 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes.
- 18 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
- 19 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
- 20 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
- 21 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
- 22 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
- 23 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
- 24 has determined that the Arkansas State Dental Examiners Board may operate
- 25 more efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Arkansas State Dental
- 26 Examiners Board authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is
- 27 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight
- 28 by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 29 Committee as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the
- 30 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this
- 31 <u>section.</u> If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
- 32 Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent
- 33 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

35 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized

36 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds

1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 4 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 14 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 18 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the 24 25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009. 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
