24	perimeter of the load within the open bed of the vehicle or trailer carrying		
25	the load. Measurements are to be taken at the perimeter of the vehicle's or		
26	trailer's bed and measured from the top edge of the bed down to the sand,		
27	gravel, or rock being transported.		
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
