## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF TIME A MEMBER OF  
10 THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM  
11 MUST TERMINATE EMPLOYMENT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR  
12 RETIREMENT BENEFITS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT OF TIME A MEMBER  
16 OF THE ARKANSAS PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'  
17 RETIREMENT SYSTEM MUST TERMINATE  
18 EMPLOYMENT IN ORDER TO QUALIFY FOR  
19 RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
23

24 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-4-520(b), concerning a member's  
25 *termination from employment for retirement purposes under the Arkansas Public*  
26 *Employees' Retirement System, is amended to read as follows:*

27 *(b)(1)* A member shall not be terminated from employment for retirement  
28 purposes if the person:

29 ~~(1)(A)~~ Returns to employment in a position covered under the  
30 system within ~~thirty (30)~~ one hundred eighty (180) days of the person's  
31 effective date of retirement; or

32 ~~(2)(B)~~ Is a member with service credit under § 24-4-521 at a  
33 rate of two (2) or more years of credited service for each year of actual  
34 service and the person returns to employment in a position covered under the  
35 system within ~~ninety (90)~~ one hundred eighty (180) days of the person's  
36 effective *date of retirement*.
