## Subtitle

15 AN ACT TO ESTABLISH AN ALTERNATE  
16 FINGERPRINT-BASED BACKGROUND CHECK.  
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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1009 is amended to read as follows:  
22 12-12-1009. Dissemination of conviction information for noncriminal  
23 justice purposes.

24 (a) Conviction information shall be made available for the following  
25 noncriminal justice purposes:

26 (1) To any local, state, or federal governmental agency that  
27 requests the conviction information for the enforcement of a local, state, or  
28 federal law;

29 (2) To any entity authorized either by the subject of the record  
30 in writing or by state or federal law to receive the conviction information;  
31 and

32 (3) To any federal agency or central repository in another state  
33 requesting the conviction information for a purpose authorized by law.

34 (b) Conviction information disseminated for noncriminal justice  
35 purposes under this subchapter shall be used only for the purposes for which  
36 it was made available and may not be redisseminated.



1 (c) Nonconviction information shall not be available under the  
 2 provisions of this subchapter for noncriminal justice purposes.

3 (d) No agency or individual shall confirm the existence or  
 4 nonexistence of criminal history information to any person or organization  
 5 that would not be eligible to receive the information pursuant to this  
 6 subchapter.

7 (e) A local agency may release its own agency records according to its  
 8 own policy.

9 (f) The Arkansas State Police Automated Fingerprint Identification  
 10 System may access and use the National Fingerprint File and Interstate  
 11 Identification Index as provided by the Federal Bureau of Investigation when  
 12 the Arkansas Code authorizes a fingerprint-based Federal Bureau of  
 13 Investigation check for a noncriminal justice purpose and a positive  
 14 identification based on fingerprints is made.

 16 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1507 is amended to read as follows:  
 17 12-12-1507. Administration.

18 (a)(1) Release of criminal history information under this subchapter  
 19 shall be made only by the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas  
 20 State Police and the Arkansas Crime Information Center as authorized by law.

21 (2) The Department of Arkansas State Police and the center may  
 22 adopt rules and regulations consistent with the provisions and intent of this  
 23 subchapter.

24 (b) The department and the center may contract with the Information  
 25 Network of Arkansas under the Information Network of Arkansas Act, § 25-27-  
 26 101 et seq., or any other qualified third-party vendor in the establishment  
 27 of the gateway or means of electronically processing transactions under this  
 28 subchapter.

29 (c)(1) The department shall not process a request for a Federal Bureau  
 30 of Investigation background check unless a corresponding state background  
 31 check through the Identification Bureau of the Department of Arkansas State  
 32 Police has also been properly requested pursuant to this subchapter.

33 (2) The requirements of subdivision (c)(1) of this section may  
 34 be waived upon written authorization of the Director of the Department of  
 35 Arkansas State Police.

36 (d) The Arkansas State Police Automated Fingerprint Identification

1 System may access and use the National Fingerprint File and Interstate  
2 Identification Index as provided by the Federal Bureau of Investigation when  
3 the Arkansas Code authorizes a fingerprint-based Federal Bureau of  
4 Investigation check for a noncriminal justice purpose and a positive  
5 identification based on fingerprints is made.

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
