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32 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the 33 Office of the Governor for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum 34 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", 35 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: seven (7) 36 temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed

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those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its
successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

4 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to 5 the Office of the Governor, to be payable from the State Central Services 6 Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of the 7 Governor for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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22 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 23 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 24 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 25 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Agency is 26 authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized in Section 27 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Governor's Office in this Act to any 28 other line item authorized in Section 3.

29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  $\frac{2007}{30}$ 30  $\frac{2009}{100}$  through June 30,  $\frac{2009}{2010}$ .

32 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 33 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES. 34 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and 35 retained, the Office of the Governor may exceed the maximum salary levels by 36 no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the

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positions authorized in the biennial operation appropriation act after
receiving approval from the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
Committee.

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SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 5 6 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 7 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 8 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 9 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 10 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 11 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 12 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 13 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

15 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 16 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 17 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 18 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 19 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 20 21 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 22 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

24 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 25 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 26 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 27 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of 28 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 29 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 30 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the 31 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 32 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 33 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 34 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009. 35

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
