16 AN ACT FOR THE OFFICE OF GEOGRAPHIC
17 INFORMATION SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR
18 THE 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Office
25 of Geographic Information Services for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the
26 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
27 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
28 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
29 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
30 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Office of Geographic Information Services for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Geographic Information Services, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Office of Geographic Information Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GEOSTOR AND FRAMEWORK. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Geographic Information Services, to be payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the duties, responsibilities and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information Board as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate and maintain Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure and to create, update, maintain and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - FLOOD MAP - FEDERAL. There is hereby appropriated, to the Office of Geographic Information Services, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses of the Department of Geographic Information Services for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DFA-SERVICE BUREAU. If the Office of Geographic Information Services in the Department of Information Systems is established as a separate agency by the 87th General Assembly, then the Department of Finance & Administration may assist the Office of Geographic Information Services to ensure all accounting and budgetary procedures are complied with. The assistance may include

1 accounting, payroll processing, personnel related actions, budgeting, and
 2 procurement.

3 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009
 4 through June 30, 2010.

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 6 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
 7 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
 8 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
 9 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 10 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 11 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 12 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 13 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 14 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 16 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
 17 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
 18 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
 19 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
 20 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
 22 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
 23 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 25 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 26 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 27 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 28 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
 29 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
 30 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
 31 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
 32 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
 33 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
 34 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
 35 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.

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
