15 AN ACT FOR THE *ARKANSAS* GEOGRAPHIC  
16 INFORMATION *OFFICE* APPROPRIATION FOR THE  
17 2009-2010 FISCAL YEAR.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the *Arkansas*  
23 Geographic Information *Office* for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following  
24 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
25 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
26 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
27 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
28 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
29 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
30 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
31 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
32 or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office* for the 2009-2010 fiscal year, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office*, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office* for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - GEOSTOR AND FRAMEWORK. There is hereby appropriated, to the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office*, to be payable

1 from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the duties,  
 2 responsibilities and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information Board  
 3 as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate and maintain  
 4 Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure and to create, update,  
 5 maintain and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code  
 6 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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12 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - FLOOD MAP - FEDERAL. There is hereby  
 13 appropriated, to the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office*, to be payable  
 14 from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the  
 15 State, for operating expenses of the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office*  
 16 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010, the following:

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28 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. DFA-  
 30 SERVICE BUREAU. If the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office* in the  
 31 Department of Information Systems is established as a separate agency by the  
 32 87th General Assembly, then the Department of Finance & Administration may  
 33 assist the *Arkansas Geographic Information Office* to ensure all accounting  
 34 and budgetary procedures are complied with. The assistance may include  
 35 accounting, payroll processing, personnel related actions, budgeting, and  
 36 procurement.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2009  
2 through June 30, 2010.

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4 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
25 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of  
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the  
30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
