27	LIVING INCREASES. Employees of the Bureau of Legislativ	
28	to positions having a labor grade shall be eligible for	_
29	increases on July 1, 2007 and July 1, 2008 in an amount	_

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 6 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 7 DISBURSING OFFICER. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research of the 8 Legislative Council shall be the disbursing officer for the funds 9 appropriated by this Act, including the Interim Committee Study Expenses. The 10 Director shall appoint a designee who shall serve as the disbursing officer 11 in his/her absence. In the event there is no Director, the Co-Chairs of the 12 Arkansas Legislative Council can appoint a disbursing officer. All expenditures from the appropriations provided by this Act shall be in 13 14 accordance with procedures established by the Legislative Council and in 15 accordance with appropriate law. 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 17 2007 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 18 SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 19 20 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 21 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 22 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 23 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 24 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 25 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 27 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 28 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 29 30 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 31 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 32 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 33 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 35 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 36 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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2	SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
3	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
4	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
5	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
6	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
7	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
8	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
9	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
10	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
11	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
12	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
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
