22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
23

24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - GENERAL OPERATIONS. There is hereby
25 established for the Department of Higher Education for the 2009-2010 fiscal
26 year, the following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall
27 be governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation
28 Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws
29 amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific
30 maximum annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
31 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
32 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
33 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
34 101), or its successor.

12 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMERGENCY
 14 GRANTS & EXTRA HELP POOL. An Institution of higher education that suffers an
 15 emergency/disaster event resulting in all or a significant portion of campus
 16 operations being interrupted, may request disaster assistance through the
 17 Arkansas Department of Higher Education. Upon the declaration of an
 18 emergency by the Governor, the institution may request, subject to the
 19 recommendation of the Director of the Department of Higher Education and
 20 approval of the Governor, a grant from the Disaster Relief Fund to assist in
 21 returning that campus to operation and/or to a sister campus providing
 22 services to the students from the affected campus. Certified law enforcement
 23 officers employed by an institution of higher education may be granted
 24 jurisdiction at the sister institution, upon agreement of both institutions.
 25 The Department of Higher Education is authorized a pool of 500 extra help
 26 positions for use in such emergency situations. These positions may be
 27 assigned to the campus suffering the disaster event or to a sister campus
 28 providing services to the students from the affected campus. The Governor
 29 may waive the 1,500 hour limit of ACA 6-63-314 on these assigned extra help
 30 pool positions.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~

 34 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 36 REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. Upon

1 determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher
2 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or
3 consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary
4 for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or
5 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have
6 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between
7 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution,
8 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
9 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used
10 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General
11 Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve
12 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education
13 prior to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
14 Provided, however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no
15 more than ~~four (4)~~ one (1) individual transaction transfer ~~requests~~ request
16 during any fiscal year and shall be further limited to no more than five
17 percent (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation,
18 funding, positions specific to each institution, and no Tobacco Settlement
19 funds or appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section.
20 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
21 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher
22 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This
23 is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation
24 act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue
25 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the
26 Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has determined that
27 institutions of higher education may operate more efficiently if some
28 flexibility is provided to institutions of higher education authorizing broad
29 powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate
30 that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of
31 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this
32 section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint
33 Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement
34 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled
35 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is
36 void.

4 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LOANS. In
6 order to provide timely payments under financial aid appropriations made in
7 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State is authorized to provide
8 loans from the Budget Stabilization Trust Fund to make available all funds
9 attributable to the financial aid programs under the then current official
10 revenue estimates. In the event of an unanticipated state revenue shortfall,
11 any such loans remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall be repaid from
12 revenues distributed in the first two months of the next fiscal year. Funds
13 for appropriations made in this Act for purposes other than financial aid
14 shall not be affected by the application of this provision.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~

18 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK
20 FORCE 2000 DEVELOPMENT FUND PROCEDURES. After the amounts to be made
21 available to the various technical colleges have been determined as set out
22 in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2), such documents as may be necessary shall be
23 processed so that funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000
24 Development Fund to the State Treasury fund or fund account from which the
25 technical college draws its general revenue support. Such funds as may be
26 transferred shall not exceed ~~93.69%~~ 93.691% of the total funds available from
27 the Work Force 2000 Development Fund during ~~each the~~ each fiscal year ~~of the~~
28 ~~biennial period ending June 30, 2009.~~

29 In the event that a technical institute or comprehensive lifelong learning
30 center which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund as
31 determined by law transfers or merges into the Arkansas Technical College and
32 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies
33 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force
34 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational
35 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of
36 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

1 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
2 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

4 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BUILDING
6 MAINTENANCE FUND. After the sum of \$13,200,000 has been deposited into the
7 Higher Education Building Maintenance Fund, the next \$10,000,000 or so much
8 as is collected, is to be transferred to the Research Development Fund there
9 to be used as provided by law.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~
11 2009 through June 30, ~~2009~~ 2010.

13 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
14 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. REFUND TO
15 EXPENDITURES. Proceeds derived from the repayment of loans as authorized in
16 Items (15), (16) and (05) of Section 4 of this Act for the JR/SR Minority
17 Teacher Scholars, the Minority Masters Fellows and the State Teacher
18 Assistance Resource Program shall be deposited into the State Treasury fund
19 from which it originated. ~~as "Refunds to Expenditures."~~

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2007~~

23 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

25 GUARD TUITION ~~ASSISTANCE~~ INCENTIVE PROGRAM. In addition to any other
26 provisions of law, any student who receives assistance from the appropriation
27 made for the "National Guard Tuition ~~Assistance~~ Incentive Program" in this
28 Act shall repay any loans and/or assistance if the student receives a
29 discharge that is a less than Honorable Discharge. Priority for funding shall
30 be given to students already receiving assistance from the National Guard
31 Tuition ~~Assistance~~ Incentive Program.

35 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 SAVINGS BONDS. The Department of Higher Education shall adopt rules and
2 regulations for the allocation of the funds reappropriated for the
3 development of projects at State Institutions of Higher Education and the
4 payment of project costs and expenses of the issuance of the bonds of the
5 Arkansas College Savings General Obligation Bonds Program to ensure that
6 funds are allocated and expended in a manner consistent with the provisions
7 of the Internal Revenue Code applicable to the Arkansas College Savings
8 General Obligation Bond Program (Program). The funds reappropriated for the
9 development of projects at State Institutions of Higher Education and the
10 payment of project costs and expenses of the issuance of the bonds of the
11 Arkansas College Savings General Obligation Bonds Program shall be allocated
12 and expended pursuant to the provisions of Arkansas Code 6-62-701 et. seq.

18 SECTION 37. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
20 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
21 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
24 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
25 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
26 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
27 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
28 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
