SAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EMERGENCY GRANTS & EXTRA HELP POOL. An Institution of higher education that suffers an emergency/disaster event resulting in all or a significant portion of campus operations being interrupted, may request disaster assistance through the Arkansas Department of Higher Education. Upon the declaration of an emergency by the Governor, the institution may request, subject to the recommendation of the Director of the Department of Higher Education and approval of the Governor, a grant from the Disaster Relief Fund to assist in returning that campus to operation and/or to a sister campus providing services to the students from the affected campus. Certified law enforcement officers employed by an institution of higher education may be granted jurisdiction at the sister institution, upon agreement of both institutions. The Department of Higher Education is authorized a pool of 500 extra help positions for use in such emergency situations. These positions may be assigned to the campus suffering the disaster event or to a sister campus providing services to the students from the affected campus. The Governor may waive the 1,500 hour limit of ACA 6-63-314 on these assigned extra help pool positions. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007

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2009 through June 30, 2009 2010.

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SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES FOR INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION. Upon

- determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher
- 2 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or
- 3 consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary
- 4 for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or
- 5 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have
- 6 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between
- 7 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution,
- 8 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 9 Committee. The transfers of positions, programs, or activities shall be used
- 10 for those purposes for which the appropriations were approved by the General
- 11 Assembly. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve
- 12 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education
- 13 prior to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
- 14 Provided, however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no

The Arkansas Department of Higher Education shall be authorized to expense costs associated with the 20 21 administration of the program, from funds made payable from the Higher 22 Education Grants Fund Account for the Student Undergraduate Research 23 Fellowship Program as authorized in Section 4 of this Act. 24 25 SECTION 34. 9	SECTION 36. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
10	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
11	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
12	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
13	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
14	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
15	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
16	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
17	
18	SECTION 37. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
19	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
20	appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
21	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of
22	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
23	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
24	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the
25	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
26	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
27	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
28	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009.
