Upon determination by the president or chancellor of an institution of higher 10 11 education that a reallocation of resources for purposes of reorganization or 12 consolidation of administrative functions within the institution is necessary 13 for efficient and effective operations of the institution, the president or 14 chancellor, with approval of the institution's board of trustees, may have 15 the authority to transfer positions, appropriations and related funds between 16 campuses, divisions, branches, and other budgetary units of the institution, 17 after receiving prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. The transfers, consolidations, or reorganizations which involve 21 academic programs shall be reviewed by the Department of Higher Education 22 prior to submission to the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 23 Provided, however, that the institution shall be limited to submitting no 24 more than four (4) two (2) individual transaction transfer requests during 25 any fiscal year and shall be further limited to no more than five percent 26 (5%) of the total General Revenue and Special Revenue appropriation, funding, 27 positions specific to each institution, and no Tobacco Settlement funds or 28 appropriations may be reallocated pursuant to this section. 29 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 30 appropriation and general revenue funding for institutions of higher 31 education each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This 32 is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation 33 act(s) for institutions of higher education and the general revenue 34 allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the 35 Revenue Stabilization law. If the requirement 7 of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled 8 unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is 9 void.

Administrative functions and 24 responsibilities may include, but not necessarily be limited to, the 25 development of eligibility criteria, collection of applications, coordination 26 of student evaluations, distribution of public notices, and funding of grants 27 for academic research purposes. Staff of the Arkansas Department of Higher 28 Education shall administer this program. The Arkansas Department of Higher 29 Education shall be authorized to expense costs associated with the 30 administration of the program, from funds made payable from the Higher Education Grants Fund Account for the Student Undergraduate Research 31 32 Fellowship Program as authorized in Section 4 of this Act. 33

SECTION 43. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 31 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 32 33 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the 34 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 35 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 36

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
