- 11 shall immediately notify by written notification the chairpersons of the
- 12 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007
- 14 through June 30, 2009.

- 16 SECTION 39. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STUDENT
- 18 UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP (SURF) PROGRAM. The focus of the Student
- 19 Undergraduate Research Fellowship (SURF) Program is the continued development
- 20 of undergraduate academic research efforts at Arkansas colleges and
- 21 universities. The Arkansas Department of Higher Education shall adopt rules
- 22 and regulations necessary for the proper administration of the Student
- 23 Undergraduate Research Fellowship Program. Administrative functions and
- 24 responsibilities may include, but not necessarily be limited to, the
- 25 development of eligibility criteria, collection of applications, coordination
- 26 of student evaluations, distribution of public notices, and funding of grants
- 27 for academic research purposes. Staff of the Arkansas Department of Higher
- 28 Education shall administer this program. The Arkansas Department of Higher
- 29 Education shall be authorized to expense costs associated with the
- 30 administration of the program, from funds made payable from the Higher
- 31 Education Grants Fund Account for the Student Undergraduate Research
- 32 Fellowship Program as authorized in Section 4 of this Act.
- 34 SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 36 COOPERATION AGREEMENTS. Any two-year institution of Higher Education that has

- 1 its main or a satellite campus located within a twenty five mile radius of 2 any four-year institution of higher education shall enter into a written 3 agreement with that four-year institution which must address duplication of 4 services between the institutions. 5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2007 6 2009 through June 30, 2009 2010. 7 8 SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code §22-5-809(c)(1) concerning the 9 distribution of severance taxes to institutions of higher education is amended to read as follows: 10 11 (c) (1) Except for application and bid fees, all funds received by the 12 Commissioner of State Lands as fees, compensation, or royalties for leases or permits issued for the taking of any sand, gravel, minerals, or timber for 13 14 lands owned or held in the name of a state agency or institution shall be 15 special revenues and shall be deposited in the State Treasury and credited to 16 the fund or account from which the agency or institution receives its support 17 and for lands owned or held in the name of a state institution of higher education shall be deposited in the State Treasury and transferred by warrant 18 to the institution of higher education for deposit in the institution's cash 19 20 fund account established outside the State Treasury. 21 22 SECTION 42. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 23 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 24 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 25 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 26 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 27 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 28 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 30 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 31 32 SECTION 43. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 33 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 34 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 35 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 36 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by

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| 5 | SECTION 44. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General |
| 6 | Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the |
| 7 | appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the |
| 8 | effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2009 is essential to the operation of |
| 9 | the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in |
| 10 | the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective |
| 11 | date of this Act beyond July 1, 2009 could work irreparable harm upon the |
| 12 | proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. |
| 13 | Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being |
| 14 | necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and |
| 15 | safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2009. |
