Arkansas Code § 24-7-717 is amended to read as follows: 25 26 24-7-717. Rescission of termination of active membership retirement. 27 (a) A retirant under this chapter who has not attained age seventy two 28 (72) is not required to receive mandatory distributions may rescind the decision to terminate active membership retire and may become an active 29 30 member upon reemployment employment by a covered employer. (b) Persons rescinding their decisions A retirant who rescinds his or 31 32 her decision to terminate active membership their retirement shall file a 33 written rescission election to rescind on the form furnished by the Board of 34 Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System. 35 (c) The rescission shall become under subsection (b) of this section is effective the first day of the calendar month next following the date the 36

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written rescission election to rescind is received by the board system.

(d)(1) Upon rescission, a former retirant shall be considered an

active member and shall accrue additional credited service subject to the

4 provisions of subsection (e) of this section.

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- (2) Any <u>retirement</u> annuity <u>benefit formerly previously</u> due from the <u>Arkansas Teacher Retirement System</u> shall be terminated upon the effective date of the rescission.
- 8 (e)(1)(A) If reemployment a retirant who has elected to rescind his or
 9 her retirement terminates covered employment before the end of the fiscal
 10 year in which a former retirant he or she has accumulated at least three (3)
 11 years one (1) year of additional credited service, the former retirant shall
 12 become a retired member, and the payment of the annuity the member's
 13 retirement benefits shall resume upon the termination at the same benefit
 14 amount prior to the rescission.
- 15 (B) The former retirant shall be entitled to receive any
 16 member contributions which may have been made during the reemployment period
 17 If the member retires again before serving the required additional one (1)
 18 year of service under subdivision (e)(1)(A) of this section, the system shall
 19 refund without interest:
- 20 <u>(i) A member contribution that is credited to the</u> 21 system after the election to rescind retirement; and
- 22 <u>(ii) A member contribution that is not included in</u> 23 the member's retirement benefits.
 - (2) If reemployment terminates after the end of the fiscal year in which the former retirant has accumulated at least three (3) years one (1) year of additional credited service, then upon termination of reemployment, the former retirant the rescinded member shall become a retired member and receive an annuity which has been recalculated according to the benefit formula in effect at the time of the termination of reemployment.
 - (f) Effective July 1, 1993, if a retirant has previously rescinded his or her decision to terminate active membership and has become an active member by reemployment, but after becoming a retirant and before rescinding had been employed in a position covered by the system, as an active member he or she shall be eligible to purchase the previous service by:
- 35 (1) Fulfilling the requirements set out in subdivision (e)(2) of this section:

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1	(2) Returning to the system all retirement benefits received
2	during the employment, together with regular interest from the date of
3	receipt of the payments to the date of repayment in full; and
4	(3) Paying to the system both member and employer contributions
5	for the previous service rendered after becoming a retirant but before
6	rescinding, plus regular interest from the date of reemployment to the date
7	of payment in full.
8	$\frac{(g)(f)}{(1)}$ A retirant under § 24-7-702 may rescind the decision to
9	terminate active membership and may become an active member upon reemployment
10	for the purpose of participation in the retire and may elect to participate
11	in the Teacher Deferred Retirement Option Plan beginning in the next fiscal
12	year after the date the member meets the eligibility requirements.
13	(2) Upon reemployment and completion of credited service
14	required to meet the minimum conditions of participation in the plan, the
15	reemployed retirant may elect to participate in the plan.
16	(3) If reemployment a rescinded member terminates covered
17	<pre>employment before the end of the fiscal year in which a former retirant has</pre>
18	worked at least three (3) years he or she is entitled to at least one (1)
19	year of additional credited service, then the former retirant shall: member
20	shall forfeit any additional benefit accruals credited after the effective
21	date of rescission.
22	(A) Become a retired member, and the payment of the
23	annuity at the time of recission shall resume upon the termination;
24	(B) Be entitled to receive any member contributions that
25	may have been made during the reemployment period; and
26	(C) Forfeit any accumulated funds in the plan.
27	(4) If the former retirant's reemployment terminates after the
28	end of the fiscal year in which the former retirant has accumulated at least
29	three (3) years of credited service, then upon termination of reemployment
30	the former retirant shall become a retired member and receive an annuity
31	along with any funds accumulated while participating in the plan.
32	(g) The election to rescind under this section may be exercised only
33	once by the member or retirant.
34	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
35	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain provisions of the
36	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System Act are badly in need of revision and

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1	updating to bring them into conformance with sound public pension policy;
2	that such revision and updating is of great importance to members of the
3	Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and to other citizens of the State of
4	Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary in order to maintain an
5	orderly system of benefits for the member of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement
6	System. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
7	necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
8	become effective on July 1,2009.
