# A Bill

SENATE BILL 237

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT POLICE OFFICERS AND  
FIREFIGHTERS WITH CERTAIN DISEASES WILL BE  
PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN INJURED IN THE LINE OF DUTY  
FOR DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFITS UNDER THE  
LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM AND UNDER  
FIRE PENSION FUNDS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO PROVIDE THAT POLICE OFFICERS AND  
FIREFIGHTERS WITH CERTAIN DISEASES WILL  
BE PRESUMED TO HAVE BEEN INJURED IN THE  
LINE OF DUTY FOR DISABILITY RETIREMENT  
BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend Arkansas Code, Title  
24, Chapter 10 to provide that police officers and firefighters with certain  
diseases will be presumed to have been injured in the line of duty for  
disability retirement benefits.
